

Road, go North on Lake Road approx. 25 miles. Look for a marker on the road for Superior Falls. Turn North (right) on that gravel road to the parking lot. Walk the trail to the river mouth and Lake Superior. Then walk upstream 1/3 mile to Superior Falls. Superior Dam Falls is a little further upstream. If you have time, stop at Little Girl's Point Park for a picnic.

AGATE FALLS

A large waterfall with a well marked trail and easy to find.

Directions: Go 6.5 miles East of Bruce Crossing on Hwy. M-28. You will see a sign on the Hwy. at the Bridge. Park in the parking area on the south end. Follow the well marked trail under the bridge to the waterfall.

BOND FALLS

A unique large waterfall that you should NOT miss, located on the middle branch of the Ontonagon River. This waterfall has been photographed for commercials and other various advertisements.

Directions: Take Hwy. U.S. 45 to the town of Paulding. You will find the waterfall 2.5 miles East of Paulding on Bond Falls Road. Walk the well marked and cultivated trails to the waterfall.

OFF THE BEATEN PATH WATERFALLS

These waterfalls are "off the beaten path". They take a little more effort but are worth the time.

CASCADE FALLS

This waterfall has an array of steps with a tremendous amount of water, located on the West branch of the Ontonagon River.

Directions: Heading East of Bergland on M-28, take USFS 222 (Forest Hwy. 222, becomes 400 Forest Hwy) Northeast from M-28. You will see a well-marked parking lot to the right. Walk the mile groomed trail to the waterfall.

MAPLE CREEK

Just past the driveway to Potawatomi & Gorge waterfalls (on the Black River National Forest Scenic Byway) is Maple Creed Road on your left. Take the first road in about 4 miles to the bridge and find a parking spot. The falls are below the bridge and upstream. Downstream is Lake Superior about 1/2 mile.

NARROWS

Drive approx. 3 miles on the Black River National Forest Scenic Byway (refer to directions to Scenic Byway at the beginning of waterfall article) to Narrows Spring Campground. The falls are downhill at the north end of the park.

CHIPPEWA

Drive approx. 5 miles on the Black River National Forest Scenic Byway (BRNRSB - refer to directions to Scenic Byway at the beginning of waterfall article) to the Copper Peak Ski Flying Hill. Follow the road around landing area. Falls 1/4 mile east. No Trail - difficult to walk.

ALGONQUIN

Drive approximately 5 miles on the BRNRSB to the Copper Peak Ski Flying Hill. Follow the road around landing area. Falls 1/4 mile northeast. No Trail - difficult to walk.

NELSON CANYON FALLS

A scenic 45 minute hike to the waterfalls that is not difficult. Take your time and explore this area.

Directions: Three miles West of Lake Gogebic on Hwy 64 take C Camp Rd.; cross Nelson Creek (culverts) and continue for almost one mile until you see a path as you're going uphill. Take the path and follow the river downstream.

PETERSON FALLS (a.k.a Interstate Falls)

Located on the East branch of the Montreal River. Follow US Hwy. 51 North to its end and then merge West on US Hwy. 2. About a quarter mile turn right (North) at the little white sign. Park and hike the dirt trail. You'll run into a smaller falls along the way if you're taking your time to explore.
